



GOWANUS VISUAL ART STUDIOS RENTAL LOTTERY APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS, FALL 2013

All entries for the Spaceworks Gowanus Visual Art Studios Rental Lottery will be collected online. There is a one-time, nonrefundable \$10 submission processing fee.

THE SUBMISSION DEADLINE FOR THE GOWANUS LOTTERY IS OCTOBER 15, 2013, AT 11:59PM!
All entries must be submitted before this time to be eligible.

Applications submitted before the deadline will be added to the Gowanus Lottery. The lottery will randomly select submissions to be reviewed by the Spaceworks Intake Advisory Committee. Spaceworks visual art studios are rented exclusively for the creation of artworks; Spaceworks artists must sustain an active artistic practice. Selected qualifying artists will be eligible to rent one-year renewable rentals of the Gowanus studios. Spaceworks is non-curatorial—all NYC residents can apply.

1. Register on spaceworksnyc.org

The first step towards entering the Gowanus Lottery is registering online at spaceworksnyc.org. After you register you can access the application portal.

2. Submit your entry

After registering, the link to start working on your entry can be found at spaceworksnyc.org/visualartstudios/apply.

In order to submit an entry for the Gowanus Lottery artists must first create a user account with Submittable.com, Spaceworks' submission manager. Once you have created a Submittable.com user account you will be able to start, save and submit your lottery entry at your convenience. *Please note: there is a one-time, nonrefundable \$10 submission processing fee.*

You will be asked to submit the following materials:

- a. Up to 8 Work Samples. Artists are encouraged to submit samples of work created within the last 2 years. Accepted formats: JPG, GIF, TIFF, PNG, MOV, AVI and/or MPG. *Please note: videos shall not exceed a runtime of 2 minutes. All files must be under 100MB each.*
- b. Artist Resume. Limit 10,000 characters.
- c. Statements. Limit 1000 characters each:
 - Artist Statement: what motivates you as an artist?
 - Technical Statement: What materials and processes have you employed in your work samples?
 - Intended Use of Space: Why do you need an affordable studio space? Please include upcoming exhibitions, commissions, etc.

You will receive a confirmation email when your entry is received.
